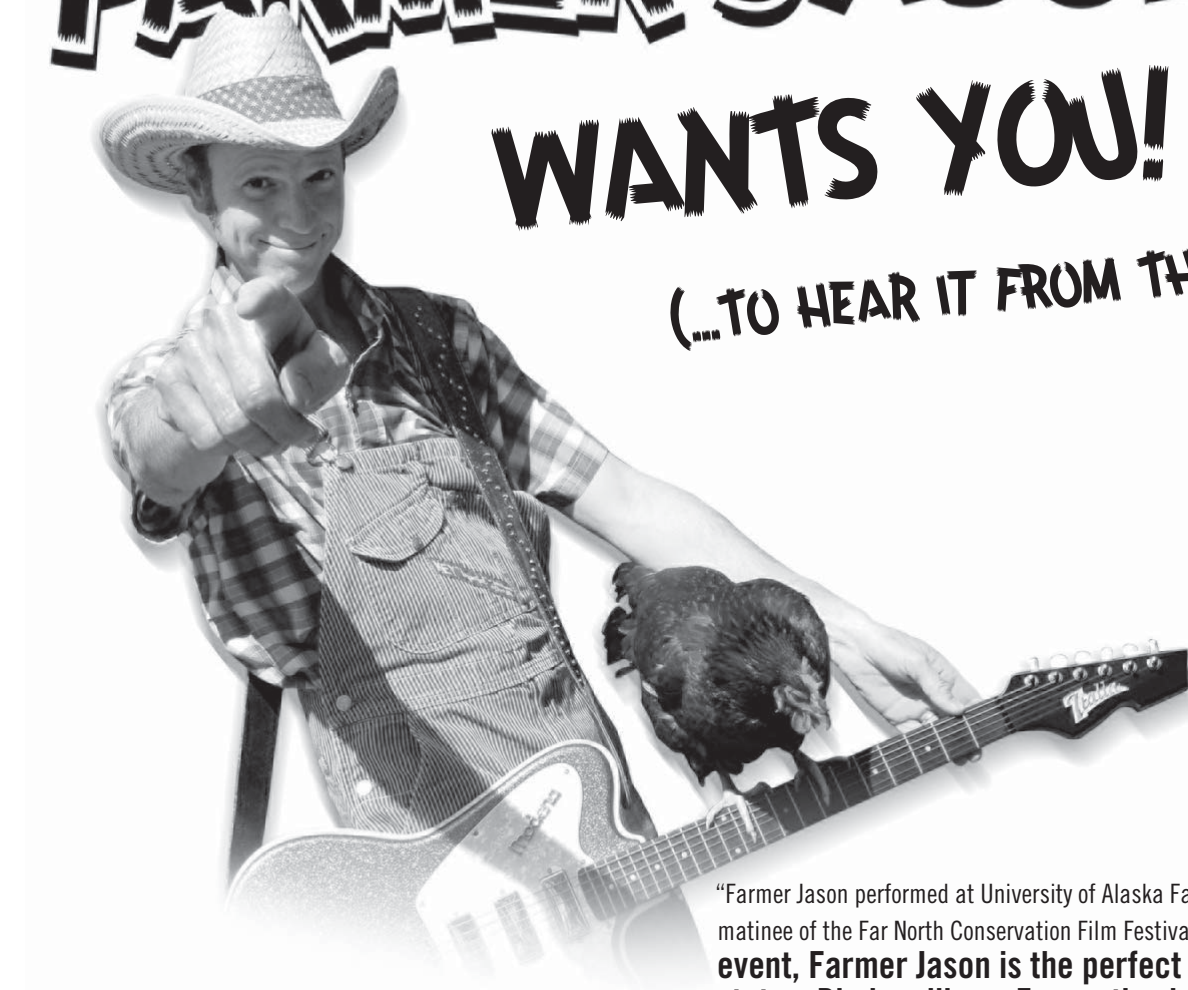


FARMER JASON

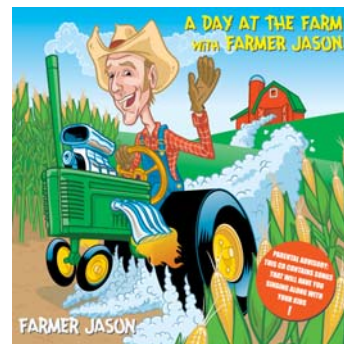
